APPENDIX A – PERFORMANCE STANDARDS

The LTA performance standards for artificial lighting within the prescribed areas of a tennis court are set out as follows:-

Re: Four Marks Recreation Ground – Tennis Court Lights

Further to your recent enquiry we now have pleasure in submitting our quotation of **£1,897.63** (One Thousand, Eight Hundred and Ninety-Seven Pounds, Sixty-Three Pence) for replacing 6No. existing floodlights with new 150Watt LED Sports Field light fittings, fitted to existing column brackets around 1No. Tennis Court.

We have not priced a discharge lamp option due to the difficulties in obtaining compatible parts.

The proposed fittings will look similar to your existing floods but we feel sure that you will notice a huge improvement in light level and distribution quality.

We have assumed that we would access the fittings by means of mobile scaffolding.

The above quoted sum will remain fixed for a period of 30days from the above date and have been calculated exclusive of Value Added Tax, which would be added at the appropriate rate upon completion.

We trust that this information meets with your approval and look forward to receiving your further instructions in due course.
