Legislation on 'E-Scooters' (Powered transporters.)

The legislation states that on public land, E-Scooters must comply with the same rules as motor vehicles, currently it is not possible to insure these and so they are not legal on public land unless involved in the E-Scooter trial;

As Four Marks is not included in the trial area, E-Scooters cannot be used on public land and so if the Council was to permit the use, it could become a destination for those wishing to use them. This type of vehicle can be used on private land with the permission of the landowner.

Currently, within the Recreation Ground Rules of Use, there is no specific mention of this type of vehicle in the limitations of use.
