Agenda Item 6.1

Following a report and representation made by a member of the public at the meeting which was held on the 7th February 2024, members of the Open Spaces Committee held a meeting with the individual. Following on from that meeting, Councillors are asked to provide an oral report so that the Committee can decide whether:

- They are in agreement that a residents group, organised by the original requester could be formed to carry out works to Kingswood Copse.
- If the Committee is in agreement with a group of resident volunteers doing the works, what the scope would be and any timelines.
- If the Committee wish to undertake any hedgerow planting either side of the wooden fence (access point from A31).
- If the Committee would like to section off a portion near to the point of access from the A31 considering the two suggested points by the resident (one near to the access point and one further down near to the Kingswood Rise entrance).

The suggestions that were made at the site meeting were made with the intention of protecting the SINC status of the area and maintaining the area for wildlife.

Agenda item 6.2

The Committee is asked to formally review the grass cutting deposits at the football pitch. A solution was found whereby the allotments would be provided with the grass cuttings and they seem to have been well received. An allotment holder has written into the Parish Office expressing that they have been pleased with the grass cuttings.

If the Committee would like to continue with the arrangement, consideration would need to be given to who will move the grass cuttings.

Agenda Item 6.3

The Committee are asked to note whether they are satisfied with the clearance of the debris from the banks of the Recreation Ground. A solution that the Committee could consider would be getting the contract gardener to remove and dispose of the waste.

Notes from EHDC Enforcement Team

16th February 2024

Arrived at 09:06

I foot patrolled the area, including the playground, football pitch - full size & smaller pitch, perimeter of tennis courts & the skate park area. I noticed 3 fresh dog fouls during my visit, 2 of which were on the field to the rear of the pavilion and 1 near the tennis courts.

There are plenty of bins and signage in the area.

Seven dog walkers were seen but no fouling was witnessed.

There was signage around the perimeter of the smaller field which requested dog owners to keep there dogs on leads. There is no PSPO in place for this. I witness 3 dog walkers in contravention of the signage, all of which I spoke with and requested that they put their dogs onto leads.

The area in general is well kept and tidy. There were 11 instances of litter found, all of which was located around the perimeters of the fields and tennis court.

I do not believe there is a major issue with dog fouling in this area however, another patrol may be required in an attempt to catch those responsible for leaving behind 3 dog fouls.

14th February 2024

Arrived at 09:56

I spoke to Victoria in the parish council office, she thinks that the main problem is on the cricket field & is currently ordering some new signage for the area.

I foot patrolled the area again as I did on Monday 12th February 2024.

The playground, football pitch - full size & smaller pitch & the skate park area with no signs of any dog fouling in the area.

Four dog walkers seen and one fouling witnessed that was immediately picked up.

I spoke to another dog walker & she did not feel that there was an issue here and said it was clean and the people who visit are well behaved, like most in Four Marks.

This is the cleanest area that I have patrolled as a hotspot & I do not see any issues at all in the area.

I do not recommend another patrol as there are no issues with dog fouling or littering in the area.
