5. EXHUMATION

If the exhumed body is <u>not</u> to be subsequently re-buried, the new resting place for the exhumed body <u>must</u> be declared when booking an exhumation.

Exhumation is only permitted with the appropriate authority, which may be a Ministry of Justice licence and/or a faculty from the Church of England. All the required permissions must be obtained by the person applying for the exhumation.

	the time of the child's death.
