EXHUMATION</b>	<p>If the exhumed body is <b>not</b> to be subsequently re-buried, the new resting place for the exhumed body <b>must</b> be declared when booking an exhumation.</p> <p>Exhumation is only permitted with the appropriate authority, which may be a Ministry of Justice licence and/or a faculty from the Church of England. All the required permissions must be obtained by the person applying for the exhumation.</p>

<b>5.2</b>	<b>Exhumation Fee (cremated remains)</b> Please note that the exhumation of cremated remains is only possible if the ashes are known to have been interred within a container.	Cost on application
<b>6.</b>	<b>SEARCHES</b>	
<b>6.1</b>	For a search in the Registers in the custody of the Council to seek and entry, successful or not.	<b>£25 (per hour + 1 copy)</b>
<b>6.2</b>	For furnishing a copy of an entry in a Register	<b>£10 (additional copies)</b>
<b>7.</b>	<b>OTHER MATTERS</b>	
<b>7.1</b>	These charges are effective from 1 <sup>st</sup> April 2025 and may be altered from time to time as the Council decides.	
<b>7.2</b>	<p>The fees set out above apply where the person to be interred or in respect of whom the right is granted is, or immediately before their death was, an inhabitant or parishioner of the Parish of Four Marks or, in the case of a still born child, where the parents (or one of them) are, or in the time of interment were, such inhabitants or parishioners.</p> <p>The term 'parishioner' shall include:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Anyone who ceased to be an inhabitant of the Parish less than one year before the date of their death.</li> <li>Anyone whose name appears on the Register of Electors of the Parish in force at the time of their death.</li> <li>A child under 21 years of age, one of whose parents qualifies as a parishioner at the time of the child's death.</li> <li>A resident of a Care or Nursing Home, or equivalent definition who, immediately before entering the Home was an inhabitant of the parish.</li> </ol>	
<b>7.3</b>	The above fees include expenses incidental to preparation of necessary documents.
