Four Marks Parish Council accepts that in isolation this application does not meet the thresholds identified in Sch 2, Category 10 (B) of the Town and Country Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2017. However, the Council considers that the cumulative potential harm and impact of the planning applications in close proximity to this site (20252/004, 50216/002, 2955./037, EHDC-25-0313-OUT, 56082/004) should be considered.

25.47 PC ADDITIONAL PLANNING MATTERS

25.47.01 To receive update on Neighbourhood Plan and drop-in sessions.

The Chairman reported that the Government's spending review removed all funding and free technical packages for Neighbourhood Planning – existing technical packages running will be completed. Four Marks & Medstead Neighbourhood Plan has two packages running so will need additional funding for master planning and what would have been received in grants. District Councillors have agreed to increase funding from their allowance to keep the Neighbourhood Plan going. The Steering Group is looking for funding elsewhere (strategic CIL may be a possibility). The call for sites has now closed with eight additional sites with two discontent landowners who submitted after the deadline.
